**CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 17:
(Appointment of Lien Resolution Administrator)**

The Parties have advised the Court that Defendants have entered into an agreement with Plaintiffs' Lead Counsel that will offer a substantial percentage of Plaintiffs with cases pending in this MDL the opportunity to resolve their claims. ECF No. 661. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 53, the Court hereby appoints a Lien Resolution Administrator ("LRA") to aid the Parties in the administration of the settlement program, as set forth in more detail below.

In the exercise of the Court's authority to manage its docket and to ensure the timely and efficient performance of the actions necessary to satisfy the conditions of the Settlement, it is **ORDERED**:

1. BrownGreer PLC is appointed as the LRA.
2. The LRA is responsible for the duties set forth in the Settlement assigned to the Lien Resolution Administrator, including assisting Claimants and

Claimants' Counsel in identifying and satisfying/resolving liens against settlement awards relating to medical care, pursuant to the parties' Master Settlement Agreement, applicable law, and as determined appropriate for the type of lien.

3. The LRA must coordinate with the QSF Administrator, Settlement Administrator, and the SCF Allocation Master regarding any holdbacks implemented to ensure such liens are properly addressed and satisfied as necessary.

4. The LRA will provide regular reports to the Court on the progress of the performance of its duties.

5. To facilitate the performance of its duties, all claimants and claimants' counsel must cooperate with reasonable requests for information from the LRA.

6. All costs and expenses for use of the LRA will be paid by Settling Claimants.
